إن المجموعة الدولية لمعالجة الأزمات (ICG) هي منظمة مستقلة غير ربحية متعددة الجنسيات يعمل بها 100 (مائة) موظفاً في 5 (خمس) قارات، يعملون من خلال التحليل الميداني الموجه للمستويات القيادية لمنع وحل النزاعات.

يعتمد أسلوب عمل ICG على البحث الميداني. وتتواجد فرق من المحللين السياسيين داخل أو بالقرب من البلدان المهددة باندلاع، وتصعيد أو إعادة وقوع النزاع المسلح. واستناداً إلى المعلومات والتقييمات التي تردها من الميدان، فإن ICG تضع تقارير تحليلية عديدة، تحتوي على توصيات عملية، وموجهة إلى صناع القرار الدوليين الرئيسيين. كما تصدر ICG نشرة شهرية بعنوان CrisisWatch تتكون من 12 صفحة تحتوي على آخر تطورات الصراعات في المناطق المعرضة للصراع في العالم.

توزع تقارير ICG على نطاق واسع بواسطة البريد الإلكتروني والنسخ المطبوعة إلى المسؤولين في وزارات الخارجية والمنظمات الدولية، وأيضاً توزع على نطاق عام بواسطة موقع المجموعة على الإنترنت (www.icg.org). تعمل ICG بالقرب من الحكومات وأولئك الذي يؤثرون عليها، بما في ذلك وسائل الإعلام، لإظهار تحليلاتها للأزمات ولتوليد التأييد لوصفاتها السياسية.

يضم مجلس إدارة ICG شخصيات بارزة في حقول السياسة، والدبلوماسية والأعمال والإعلام، الذي يقدم المساعدة لجلب اهتمام صانعي القرار على امتداد العالم إلى تقارير المجموعة وتوصياتها. يرأس ICG رئيس فنلندا السابق مارتي أهتيساري؛ رئيسها ومديرها التنفيذي هو وزير خارجية أستراليا السابق جارت إيفانز منذ شهر كانون الثاني 2000م.

يوجد مقر الإدارة الرئيسية ل ICG في بروكسل، ولها مكاتب استشارية في كل من واشنطن العاصمة، ونيويورك ولندن وموسكو. تعمل المجموعة حالياً في سبع عشر مركزاً ميدانياً (في عمان، بلغراد، بوغوتا، القاهرة، دكار، دوشنبه، اسلام اباد، جاكارتا، كابول، نيروبي، اوش، بريتوريا، بريشتينا، كويتو، سراييفو، سكوبي، وتبليسي) ويعمل محلياً في حوالي 40 منطقة معرضة للأزمات على امتداد أربع
