يضم مجلس إدارة كرايسز جروب شخصيات بارزة في حقول السياسة، والدبلوماسية والأعمال والإعلام، الذي يقدم المساعدة لجلب اهتمام صانعي القرار على امتداد العالم إلى تقارير المجموعة وتوصياتها. يرأس كرايسز جروب رئيس فنلندا السابق مارتي أهتساري؛ رئيسها ومديرها التنفيذي هو وزير خارجية أستراليا السابق جارث إيفانز منذ شهر كانون الثاني 2000م.

يوجد مقر الإدارة الرئيسية ل كرايسز جروب في بروكسل، ولها مكاتب استشارية في كل من واشنطن العاصمة، ونيويورك ولندن وموسكو. تعمل المجموعة حاليا في سبع عشر مركزا ميدانيا(في عمان، بلغراد، بوغوتا، القاهرة، دكار، دوشنبه، اسلام اباد، جاكارتا، كابول, نيروبي، اوش،بريتوريا،
